WHERE

Communities of Maraã and Várzea Grande, on the Rio Purus, Lábrea Region - AM

WHAT FOR

The communities of the Rio Purus suffer from the lack of drinking water. The inhabitants take water directly from the river and for this reason suffer from innumerable illnesses. With the perforation of semi-artesian wells we will be able to minimize this difficulty and give the inhabitants and the missionaries better living and health conditions.

OUTREACH

The wells that are dug will have water running through pipes to a large reservoir, and distributed to the riverside dwellings. This will benefit the whole population of the two villages: Várzea Grande: 200 persons, and Maraã: 100 persons.

WHEN

With resources in hand, we hope to finalize the Project in November 2019.

TEAM

Contracted professionals and volunteers from the community.

WHAT WE HAVE

We have the Project to install a mission base in the two villages, and the request of the people, totally deprived of resources. We will have the technical support of the Mission Aviation Fellowship in this venture.
